## **Introduction : -**

A Sense verb is that verb which originate by the five senses. Such as - Look, taste, seem, feel. smell and sound. These are also called as Sensory verbs.

#### For Example :-

You can see that airplane.

She looked at the painting carefully.

These are the perceptions which we receive by our senses. They all are Non – Action verbs,. They can not be in progressive forms.

## For Examples :

1.You smell good

Not as:

You are smelling good.

2. This soup tastes fantastic.

Not as

This soup is tasting good.

Normally, we should use : Can/can't with (feel, hear, see, smell, taste)

I can see a beautiful toy.

It can't be as

I am seeing a beautiful toy.

I can smell the petrol. It stinks

Not as

I am smelling petrol.

My tongue got burnt and now I can't taste the flavor.

Not AS

I am not tasting.

I can feel your heartbeat.

Not as

I am feeling your heartbeat.

These are also called as State Verbs.

For Example :-

Look and sound are stative verbs which are also the (Non Action) verbs. Sometimes, they come in continuous form. But, that time sense will be different.

For Example :-

I am seeing him now a days. ( Here, seeing means dating someone) I have been hearing (It means) Things related to court or some case or **Receiving Information.** In this sentences of Sensory Verbs, there is no receiving of direct action. You seem happy. You look sad. Where as according to the tense: I eat a banana. But I see a painting. The action is not received by the subject. He just saw the painting but He eats banana. There is an action in the banana and that's why there is consumption of food. But, in I See a painting. There is no action or subject t did not receive any action.
