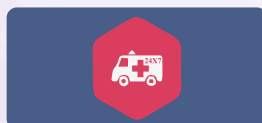

University is having residential capacity of 1500+ students so concentrating on safety security and protection measures the University has implemented a very tight security system across the campus.

- 24x7 security guards are appointed for the security of the students within the hostels and all the entry/exit points of the campus.
- Outsiders are not allowed to enter within campus premises & students are not allowed to meet any person whose photograph does not match with their registered family member.
- Use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the campus premises.
- Communication facility is available only on authorized numbers that verified by are the Parents/ Guardians.
- Security check at each entry and exit point of the University is mandatory for all .
- Full CCTV surveillance across the campus

Academic Rules

- ✓ It is an honor for every student to wear ID-Card with proper uniform during the Academic Hours, Educational visits or tours. Improper or Incomplete Uniform defeats your personality and hinders the discipline.
- ✓ Punctuality is a tool of success in life. We expect you to be regular & punctual in attending your classes.
- ✓ 80% of Academic Attendance is mandatory to appear for examinations. The attendance may be viewed by students and parents at University Website www.jvwu.ac.in using the Username and Password on login panel.
- ✓ It is advisable to carefully handle the Academic Tools that includes OHP, wall mounted Projectors and other e-resources provided in Classrooms, Lecture Theaters, Library etc.
- ✓ It is a good habit to study from e- resources such as video lectures, ejournals before attending the classes for effective learning.
- ✓ Students are expected to switch off the AC's and other power points before leaving the Classroom, Lecture hall or Labs.
- ✓ It is an unhealthy practice to consume eatables, chewing gums etc or indulge in any non academic activity such as listening music, watching movie etc in Academic Blocks.
- ✓ Wearing Lab coats while working in laboratory or workshops is the prescribed dress code. All the ultra-sophisticated instruments & modern high-tech equipments/apparatus must be used under the supervision of specialized Lab Technicians or Faculty Members. Mishandling may lead to penalize the student or group as the case may be.
- ✓ Every student is expected to give active participation in all co curricular and extracurricular activity of the university for their overall personality Development. Students are expected to follow the Code of Conduct & Notifications declared by University Officers/ Authorities from time to time.
- ✓ Student may be debarred from examination if remains absent in academics for a long time.
- ✓ Extra/ Remedial classes are provided free of charge in the evening as per requirements.



RULES & REGULATIONS

Residential Rules



At JV we aim to make a comfortable, safe and convenient stay as easy as possible. A variety of accommodation options are available. University has world class residential facilities with multistoried hostels having AC and Air-cooled facility. The rooms are allotted as per choice and availability. Rooms in University hostels are provided fully furnished with beddings. Internet and telephones in every room provides ready access to outside world under surveillance.

- ✓ Hostel rooms are allotted as per the choice and requirement of the students.
- ✓ Hostellers shall not change or interchange the allotted rooms without prior permission from University authority/ officer. Processing fee for Room Change shall be applicable on students.
- ✓ Hostellers shall not stay in hostel during Academic Hours without taking the prior approval.
- ✓ If conduct of a hosteller student is not found satisfactory, the University reserves all rights to get the accommodation vacated at any time.
- ✓ The entry of the students coming from outside shall be allowed up to 8:00 p.m. However, the gates of all the Hostels will be closed by 10:00 p.m.
- ✓ Students may take leave after obtaining gate pass with the approval of University Authority after submitting self attested Leave Application After getting permission of Parents/ Guardians duly signed or Leave Application attested by Parents/Guardians whichever is applicable.
- ✓ Parents/ Guardians whose photograph and details are pasted in the meeting form may meet their wards or take them for outing on Saturday, Sunday and on University holidays during 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.
- ✓ If any student is not able to join University on her due date then she should inform competent authority for extending the leaves and her next joining date for her convenience.
- ✓ Students can go on outing on Sunday or University holidays. If Parents/ Guardians give their prior consent.
- ✓ The Hostels shall have to be totally vacated during Summer Break for the administration, maintenance and other concerns.
- ✓ Day scholars are not allowed to stay in the hostel without permission.
- ✓ If any day boarder student wants to get accommodation in hostel in mid session then she shall have to pay the accommodation fee as per university rule.
- ✓ No poster should be pasted on the walls and cupboards in the rooms.
- ✓ Mobile are strictly not allowed within the campus. If any student found with the mobile,

then Fine of Rs. 15,000/- shall be imposed immediately

- ✓ Mobile Lockers may be hired on request to keep the mobile under security which shall be provided only during vacations & permission to use outside the campus. The locker charges shall be Rs. 1000 Yearly for Hostellers and Day Boarders.
- ✓ Students are not allowed to go in indecent dresses on university outing.
- ✓ Students must wear the ID cards during the outing.
- ✓ Students are not allowed to meet any stranger or their guardian, if going on

university outing. Late reporting in Bus will be considered Breach of Rule.

- ✓ Students are not allowed to go anywhere else except the place they are coming for an University outing.
- ✓ Students have to report back in time to university transport, if they fail to do so there outing will be cancelled for the three months.
- ✓ Any misbehave with the duty officer or anyone else will not be excused.



Code Of Conduct for Students of the University

The purpose of code of conduct outlined at Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Jaipur is to establish University's identity as an independent community which has appropriate atmosphere of higher education with distinctive history & culture.

The grounds of disciplinary proceedings are framed to maintain a safe and civil environment while educating students about their rights and responsibilities.

Interpretation of provisions of Code and Conduct of Students may be requested by contacting the University Authority/Officer.

Scope of Code of Conduct :

- Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Jaipur is located amidst of rural area, the relationship with the surrounding community is valued by the students and staff of the University and also realize that the relationship has an impact on the social, cultural and economic aspects of the villagers.
- The code of conduct of students is to elaborate University's standards for behavior and expectations from all students enrolled, in order to promote safe and positive learning environment. The proceedings will apply the disciplinary action if a student breaches the University's code of conduct or otherwise behaves in a manner that is, in the opinion of the University, detrimental to student discipline and welfare or University staff well-being.
- The discipline system is applicable to all the students enrolled in full-time on campus regular programs, distance education programs, research and certificate programs both in their on-campus conduct and off-campus conduct.
- The policies are framed for smooth functioning of the education system of the University and does not functions as a court of law and the disciplinary proceedings are considered in a manner where focus is on educational facet.
- If a student or group of students are found by the University Authority/Officer violating the civil laws or the policies of the University may be subject to either disciplinary process of the University or appropriate legal process as per the rules and regulations of the statutory bodies or regulatory authorities.
- If a student or a group of students are reported by the members of the community to have violated the laws off-campus, the University Authority/Officer will cooperate with the appropriate official for taking necessary actions. The off-campus conduct of the students has a direct impact on the mission of the University and may invite formal disciplinary actions on University.



Areas of Disciplinary Proceedings :

Students as a part of the University are responsible to the academic community and their behavior adds to the learning environment, pursuit of University mission, rights and dignity of each member of the University.

Code of Conduct

If student(s) found responsible for the violation of any clause mentioned below is subject to disciplinary sanctions. University Authority/Officer may initiate the disciplinary action against student(s) suspected of violating the code of conduct of student of the University within the jurisdiction of the Ordinance and Regulations of the University.

Do's:

- Comply with the written or oral communication of legitimate orders or directives of University Authority/Officer.
- Day boarders can use only such facilities or equipment which are meant for the use of day boarders not of hostellers and vice-versa.
- Punctual during academics, examinations, messing timings, recreational activities or any such activity scheduled or event declared by the University.
- Wear ID card and proper uniform including shoes are mandatory during academics, examinations or any such activity scheduled or event declared by the University.
- Follow the outing or leave process as mentioned by the University.
- When leaving the hostel room for academics or vacations, students should switch off the

Don'ts:

- Violate any of the clauses of the discipline system of students notified by the University from time to time.
- Conduct anything in the academic functioning which may cause threat to academic integrity. Conduct anything that leads to ragging in any form as defined by the Anti-Ragging laws by Indian Penal Code and University Grants Commission.
- Provide University Authority/Officer or student false, misleading or incomplete information, forging or altering University record or documents, conspiring with or induce others to forge or alter University record or documents.
- Fail to appear or report to any University Authority/Officer in conjunction to any disciplinary matter at the specified time.
- Theft, damage, defacement or destruction of any private or University property.
- Use University property, services, facilities and information system for any unauthorized purposes.
- Use, abuse or interference with fire protection equipment or other safety system which could result in injury, death or substantial damage of property.

Code Of Conduct for Students of the University

Don'ts:

- Possess items prohibited in University campus or use of any such substance which constitutes a significant health hazards.
- Disorderly conducts including, verbal abuses, inappropriate behaviors prohibited by the University Authority/Officer.
- Instigating a disturbance for violating University policies.
- Conduct which causes physical abuse, threat to bodily harm and acting in manner which causes a risk to bodily harm to any student or staff of the University.
- Every conduct that amounts to Sexual Harassment as the rules and regulations laid by statutory bodies and regulatory authorities.
- Unauthorized assembling of students within the campus which causes disturbance to the law & order of the University and damage to University property.
- Interfere with the rights and safety of another student whether in class or hostel room and creating a hostile environment within the residential facilities.
- Noise or behavior or playing sports that creates disturbance for other students in hostel.
- Alteration or addition of the furniture provided in the residential facilities.
- Form any organization or society, arrange events and collect funds without any prior permission of the University Authority/ Officer.
- Violate of any sort pertinent to the Indian Penal Code.
- Stay in hostel during Academic Hours.
- Exit from University Campus in an unauthorized manner. Meeting any unauthorized or unknown person during University Outing without permission of the University Authority/Officer is not allowed.
- Theft and mutilation of the library books, damage or defacing of the library property, and indulging in unlawful activities, incident or socially unacceptable behavior will be taken as a serious misconduct and people indulging in, encouraging or abetting such activities and in possession of unauthorized library books are liable for punitive action by University Authority/Officer.
- Possess mobile phone and related accessories in the campus is not allowed and strict disciplinary action and penalty shall be imposed on the students found guilty of breaching this rule.
- Cook in hostel rooms.
- Unauthorized possession of a hostel room or night stay in another hostel is not allowed.
- Undue use of the laptops for recording videos, clicking objectionable pictures, playing loud music or any other activity that may cause disturbance to the fellow students is liable to disciplinary action against such student.



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Necessary Items Required to be Brought by a Hosteller

- Decent Clothes (Jeans/ Tops/ Long Skirts/ Salwar Suits/ Sarees/ Night Suit)
- Towel, Inner Wear etc
- Socks (White/ Grey -Two Pair)
- Shoes (Black Canvas/ Belly Shoes (Without heel) as a part of Uniform)
- Toiletries/ sanitary (as per personal requirement)
- Daily Essentials- Soap, Creams, Moisturizer/Hair Oil/ Shampoo (as per personal requirement)
- Nail Cutter (Without Knife)
- Lock and Key
- Passport Size Photographs (10)
- Plastic Water Bottle
- Bucket & Mug
- Insulated Thermos/Flask of 250 ml/ Milk Mug
- Optional Items
- Laptop (not less than 14 inches & without SIM)
- Mp3 Player (without SIM slot)
- Alarm Clock
- Personal use items (without electronics)
- Electric Kettle of 500 ml or less



Penalties on Breaching of Rules

- a. All students should follow code of conduct. The act of breaching of rules will be liable for financial penalty or suspension from University or Both as the case may be. It is therefore advisable to follow the rules of the University properly.
- b. If a student is found with a mobile/ sim/ recharge coupons or related items which has been brought with or without the knowledge of parents, she will be penalized by **₹15000/-** and the same not be returned.
- c. Ragging is strictly prohibited, anyone found involved in such activity will be liable to be penalized or suspension from the University as the case may be.
- d. The other prohibited items will also come under the penalty and the same will not be returned.
- e. Punching of ID cards of any other than self is also a part of breaching of rules where a penalty of **₹5000/-** will be imposed.
- f. One should take care of the University property. Penalty amount will be imposed on the guilty student(s) who are found breaking/ destroying any University property which can be the Hostel rooms, Academic Blocks, Open Area, Transportation etc.

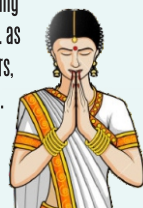

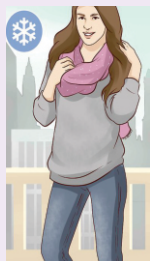

Permitted Items from Home (Optional)

- Jams or Pickles packed in Plastic Jars/ Containers only
- Dry Fruits
- Dry Sweets or Snacks such as laddoo, Barfi, Mathri etc
- Namkeen, Wafers and Biscuits
- Sprouts such as Chana, Moong etc.
- Supplements such as Bournvita/ Complain etc.
- Home cooked food
- Electric Kettle (Not more than 500 ml)
- Green Tea Bags, Sugar, Salt, Milk-Powder, Coffee, Cornflakes, Poha,
- Bread, Butter, Ghee
- Recreational indoor games such as a Playing Card, Ludo, Chess & Shuttlecock.
- Tablet without mobile sim and memory card accessible

Prohibited Items

- Sanitizers are not allowed, Use Paper Soap, Soap Bar, Hand Wash.
- Mobile, Sim Card, Mobile Charger or any item/ device in which SIM can be used such as Watch/ Pen etc.
- Camera (except Journalism Students)
- I-Pod with Camera or external memory card
- Modem/ Dongle or any other Wifi Device
- Electric Iron/ Electric Heater/ Rod/ Hair dryer/ Hair Straightener or such other electric items.
- Battery Operated Portable Items such as Juicer/ Fan etc
- Any item that has a blade or is sharp (Such as : knife/ cutter/ dissection sets/ scissors)
- Match Stick/ Box etc.
- Agarbatti/ Dhoopbatti/ DiyaBatti etc.
- Glasswares
- Mosquito Repellents such as All Out, Good Knight, Coils etc
- Any Raw/ Cooking Material such as onion, potato, eggs, rice, pulses etc.
- Sports Racket/ Bat etc

We expect all students to follow the University Rules & Regulations declared in the Student Manual or declared from time to time. Breaching of rules & regulations of the University Campus may lead to consequences as mentioned below:

- First Instance of Disciplinary Matters - Information to parents with penalty.
- Second Instance of Disciplinary Matters - Penalty with Suspension.
- Third Instance of Disciplinary Matters - Rustication from University with penalty or any other action decided by University Management.

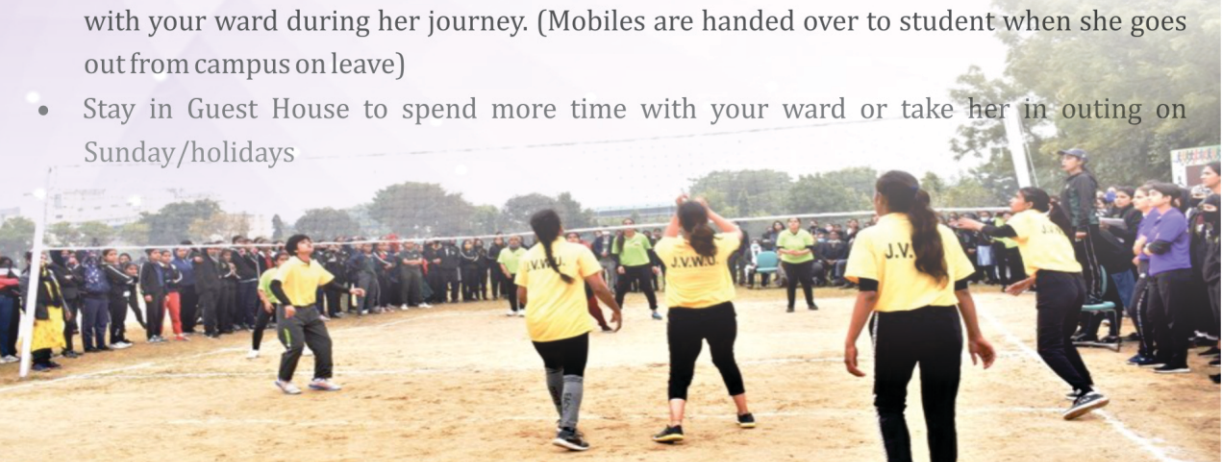
Facilities for Students

Communication facilities-

- Mobiles are strictly prohibited in the campus. All the hostellers are provided 24x7 communication facilities only on registered mobile numbers through intercoms at each hostel room. Incoming & Outgoing Calls are allowed only as per the numbers registered by their guardians. Students themselves cannot add/remove any numbers in the call list.

Connect with your Ward-

- Telephonic Communication- Be in touch with your ward on registered numbers with Landline Telephones available in each hostel rooms 24*7.
- Keep watch on your ward's incoming and outgoing call details.
- Meet Your Ward in University (person authorized by Parents only)
 - Timings-Monday to Friday – after Academic Hours (3:00 pm - 7:00 pm)
 - Saturday & Sunday- (7:00 am – 7:00 pm)
- Get Information by SMS, every time your ward Enters & Exits the University Campus (For Both Hostellers & Day Boarders)
- Send easy SMS from authorized numbers to grant leave to your Ward.
- Get notification of all important dates & timings, your ward's academic attendance/performance etc through university website by login in Parent's Portal.
- Watch your Ward's performance live on JV TV through University Website, participating at various Academic & Cultural events at University Campus.
- Send any allowed items through couriers and speed post to your ward. Checking of the parcel will be done in front of your ward before handing over it to her.
- Send important documents, convey messages, railway/flight tickets etc through email to your ward.
- Keep her mobile in Mobile locker at University's Front Reception for communicating with your ward during her journey. (Mobiles are handed over to student when she goes out from campus on leave)
- Stay in Guest House to spend more time with your ward or take her in outing on Sunday/holidays



Rules Meeting Parents/ Guardians Academic Days

Meeting Parents/ Guardians whose photo is attached in Student Profile can meet their wards on Academic Days and on Sunday or University Holiday between 7:00 AM-7:00 PM.

- a. Any one, other than the person whose photo has been given by you in the Student Profile, visits the University may only be allowed to meet their wards during prescribed timings on presenting the permission letter duly signed by the parent along with his/her own Identity proof.
- b. Parents/ Guardians may also be allowed to take their wards on outing on Saturday from 4:00 PM till Monday 8:30 AM on taking the prior permission from the University Management.

BANK & ATM

Bank and ATM facility is provided within the campus. The branch of “Bank of Maharashtra” is situated in the campus premises. Students can open Bank account at the time of admission.

- a. The branch of Bank of Maharashtra is located within the campus premises with ATM facility. Access to Bank and ATM is allowed during 4:00 PM – 6:00 PM
- b. It is advisable to carry some amount (1000/-apx.) with you for opening of the Bank account.
- c. ATM Facility is also available within the Campus premises. 24*7 access is allowed.
- d. All the students must get their accounts opened in the bank, to have a hassle free transaction of money.
- e. Excess cash in hand must be avoided.

Internet Facility

All the students have been provided the internet facility. Internet connection has given to all the students on their laptops. They are free to access Internet Labs after their academics. Internet Connectivity is given through LAN system and WI-FI Connectivity through optical fibre for high speed.

Rules:

- I. A Laptop has to be registered for free access of WI-FI connectivity from technical department (Server Room).
- II. All the students have to take Login – Password from the technical department for free access of the internet facility.

Although there is a fee access to internet yet unauthorized sites are blocked under security reasons.

Library services

The library has rich collection of relevant books to support students' information needs, the e-library is enriched with E-Textbooks, E-Journals and easy accessibility to various Digital Libraries like DELNET, MANUPATRA etc

The campus provides round the clock library facility to all the students faculty wise. The campus enjoys the fully equipped library including latest & up to date reading and reference material in print, electronic, audio, and visual formats. The admission fee of hostel shall not be refunded in any case

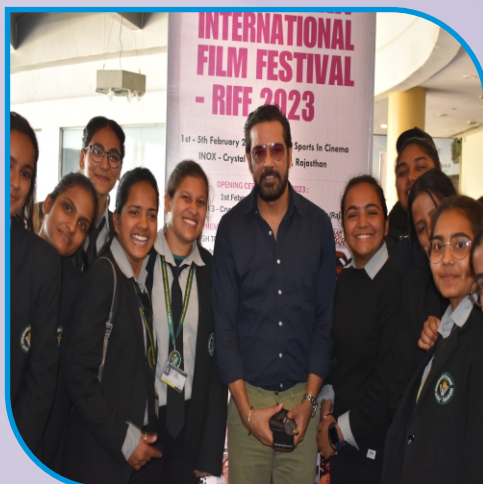
- Students will be allotted Residential/Day border Seat at the time of Admission.

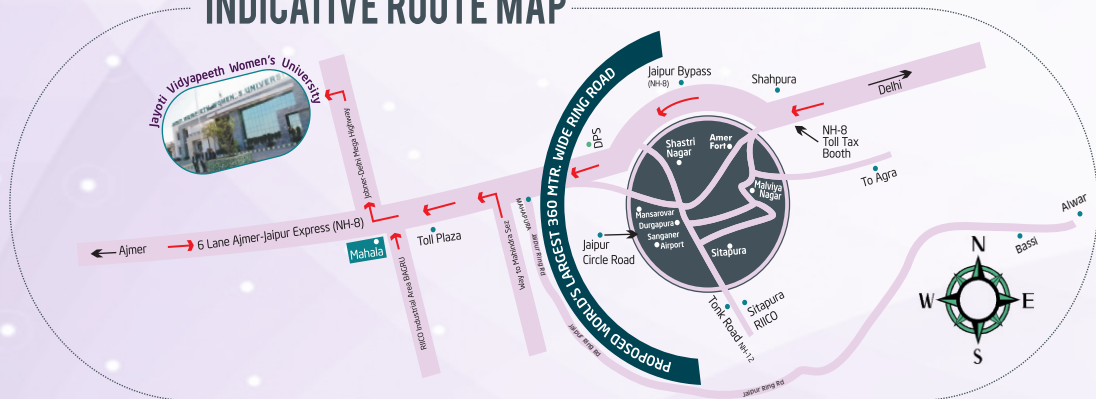
