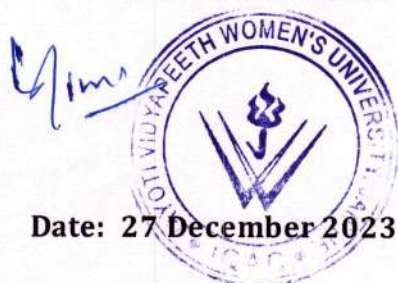
## **Infrastructure Requirements placed before IQAC**
