Action Taken Report 2023-24 Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

1. ERP Software Training for Non-Teaching Administrative Staff

To enhance the technical competency of administrative staff through training in ERP software for effective management of student records, attendance, hostel, gate pass, and finance. IQAC taken initiative to provide training to all students and staff members in different phases.
