The report tries to give a clear picture regarding the feedback system of the University through the analysis of the responses of the stakeholders on each academic year.

Feedback by the Stakeholders (Teachers, Students, Alumni & Employers) including suggestions is as follows:

- The syllabus is highly rated by the vast majority of the respondents.
- The majority of the respondents opined that the modules are logically structured and well constructed.
- The allocation of the classes is proportionate to the time stipulated in the syllabus.
- The majority of the respondents have opined that the syllabus is highly functional and activity oriented.
- Most of the respondents have opined that the internal evaluation system in the University and its syllabus orientation is extremely good and advisable.
- Some of the respondents suggested providing more placement opportunities.
- Some of the respondents suggested to improve the Canteen facility.
- Increase in the area covered by university transportation.
- Improve Wi-Fi Connectivity in hostels.
- Enrich laboratory facilities.
- Arrange more value-added courses to impart transferrable skills.
- Organize field trips to instill practical knowledge in students.
- Encourage students to engage in extracurricular activities.
- Encourage participatory learning.
