Agenda 2. To report on the action taken in the minutes of the last meeting of IQAC held on 21 October 2023

Agenda 3. To propose programme for non-teaching and supporting staff of the academic year 2023-24

The IQAC members discussed to organize training programme for non-teaching and supporting staff for smooth operations of ERP solution at all administrative level.

The Training sessions are proposed to be conducted during January 2024 – March 2024 to avoid clashes with academic schedules. Both online and in-person modes were discussed, with a preference for hands-on training in computer labs for all staff members by External experts

The IQAC members emphasized the importance of equipping non-teaching and supporting staff with necessary technical skills. It was acknowledged that training in ERP software and library software would improve operational efficiency and service delivery.

The members expressed their support for the training programs, recognizing the need to enhance the technical competencies of the non-teaching and supporting staff. The agenda was approval for implementation.
